6.	Boils	No warning	No staff used	Refused Moses' request (9:12)

7.	Hail	Warning—to Pharaoh in his palace in the morning (9:13–19)	Moses' staff (9:22–23)	Promised to let the Israelites go if the rain and hail were stopped (9:28)
8.	Locusts	Warning—to Pharaoh probably in his palace (10:3–6)	Moses staff (10:12–13)	Offered to let only the men go (10:11)
9.	Darkness	No warning	(Moses' hand; perhaps the staff was used; 10:21–22)	Agreed that the people could go but not their animals (10:24)

10.	Death of the firstborn	Warning—to Pharaoh probably in his palace (11:4–8)		Urged the people to go! (12:31–32)
